



Research-Led Peace Education as Crisis Prevention in Central Africa Second Reflexive Review

Date: Thursday 25 November 2021

Venue: A virtual meeting online

The second Reflexive Review Workshop will present and discuss the key outputs from a 20 month-long examination of the contours of peace education in Rwanda. The inquiry sought to determine whether and how peace education interventions in Rwanda are informed by research that enables participants to navigate difficult, often sensitive, topics. The workshop builds on insights from the first Reflexive Review Workshop held on 10 September 2020 in the early phases of the inquiry. The workshop will bring together individuals involved in the different phases of the inquiry. It will feature:

- A presentation and discussion of findings of a draft article on 'Locating Peace and Values Education in Rwanda'
- A presentation and discussion of finding from the Policy Report on Methods and Means of teaching Peace Education informed by fieldwork in several schools in different parts of the Rwanda
- Presentations and feedback on draft model lessons plans informed by current research
